In the United States, 2% of expectant mothers receive amniocentesis or CVS testing for genetic conditions. Recent studies show that of this 2%, the infants diagnosed with Down syndrome are aborted in 75% of cases.

Where did this myth begin?

In the 1980's, a summary of data from U.S. studies and International figures was compiled.

Why does it matter?

The myth runs the risk of encouraging terminations by making the parents believe they will be alone, or at best part of a small minority. It also creates a culture of exclusion and discrimination.

- Evidence shows that termination rates due to a Down Syndrome diagnosis have decreased in recent years
- Termination rates vary depending on the mother's age, ethnicity, and location.
- Children with Down
 Syndrome have the potential to lead happy, productive lives
- Expectant parents deserve accurate, up-to-date information
- There are support groups available that welcome new members, by providing them with resources and welcome baskets
